## Privacy concerns

- The device runs unfree software.
- The device must be on the same LAN as the controller.
- The “Kasa Smart” app is only available on specific versions of Android and iOS
- The “Kasa Smart” app is unfree software.
- The “Kasa Smart” app is only available through mayor, centralized stores.
- For setup the “Kasa Smart” app is required.
- For firmware updates the “Kasa Smart” app is required.
- For a reset the “Kasa Smart” app is required.
- During setup the “Kasa Smart” app requires location (for no apparent reason).
- During setup the “Kasa Smart” app requires your Wi-Fi passphrase.
